How Does It Work?

Credentialing can be a daunting task. Many carriers now require a contract in place before you may treat their patients and bill for your services.:

- Medicare, in particular, can be particularly cumbersome, with the sheer number of forms to complete. A solo practitioner must complete three forms just for Medicare participation.
- Applications can take time, and require great attention to detail, and follow-up,
- Once the process is complete, and the contract executed, you can treat and bill for your services.
